Greetings!

Here is a recap of the July Region minutes as I was unable to attend.

The treasury began with a balance of \$1910.00. There were deposits in the amount of \$805.57 and \$609.00 worth of checks cleared and automatic payments of \$469.92 to bring the balance to \$1636.95.

The RD report addressed many issues-

- Members from the River Rock Area were curious as to what the USSC has done for the Wisconsin region. It was discussed that the “USSC Outreach Guide was used by the Wisconsin Region Outreach Chairperson as part of a regional workshop. The results of that workshop were educational and informative due in part to that outreach guide.”
- “RRAGS has formed an ad hoc committee to investigate up the possibility of changing to a different region. A major concern that was brought forward by the ad hoc committee was regarding the Wisconsin Region Treasurer reports. Their concern was that the treasurer reports were vague and lack transparency. I reviewed some of the past regional treasurer reports and I have to agree with the findings of the ad hoc committee. I therefore would like to propose that the treasurer report begin to show the itemizing of all income and expenses. Considering that we are here to listen to Wisconsin regional area concerns I find this proposal to be appropriate. I wish this to be placed on the topic board as a priority discussion. I believe this concern can be rectified and will foster unity between all the areas in the Wisconsin region.” \*\*Going forward it was agreed that the Treasure will itemize in their reports.\*\*
- “In reference to car motions, this body requested a motion be drafted to reinstate book one (the first 10 chapter) of the basic text to be distributed to institutionalized/incarcerated members of Narcotics Anonymous in the United States especially Wisconsin. Being that this is not a motion that would affect the world fellowship, it is my feeling that this motion would be rejected by the World Board. The World Board has emphasized that any motion or proposal submitted to the World Board that does not have worldwide ramifications would not be considered for the car report.”

\*\*An email will be sent to ask about printing the baby blues, and requesting more information about printing the first 10 chapters of the basic text.\*\*

- The RD expressed concern with the Subcommittees becoming “Subcommittees of one person” \*\*Subcommittees will be meeting at Region on Saturday at 9 a.m.\*\*
- The RD also stressed the importance of attending the MZF in Wisconsin Rapids the last weekend of August.

The RD-Alt shared that Minnesota Region is looking to partner with another region(s) to share representation. It was decided the RD’s would gather more information at the MZF and present it at the next cycle.

The Big Rivers Area approved policy to donate 10% of balance after bills and prudent reserve. I know that there has been discussion as to how better improve our Area’s process for Regional donations. Maybe this is something that could be considered?

The H&I chair is working on a central document listing all meetings in the Region. She will not be listing time or day that those meetings occur to prevent someone from showing up at a meeting without going through the proper channels.

Policy gave the following updates from previous cycles-

- Topic # 6 from Mays Regional Minutes
- Proposal: Change the guidelines for the Secretary, Treasurer and Vice-Treasurer to “May not be an RCM”. Intent: Avoid conflict of interest when conducting business at region when utilizing consensus based decision making.

The recommendation of this sub-committee would be to change this before the next elections, not now since two of the three listed are RCM’s this would force someone to make a decision to resign at least one of their positions. This would not be spiritual making someone to choose which position that they should fulfill. We can change this starting their next terms.

Consensus was reached and the proposal passed.

- Topic # 9 from Mays Regional Minutes.

Reprinting of orientation guide. This will be looked into before the September region

- Topic # 10 from Mays Regional Minutes.

Reimbursement of WRSO Rep’s.; This is already addressed in our Guidelines.

The following was included in the PR report “I would recommend that everyone keep an eye on the web page meeting list both the online version and the printable version. With that said I would like to see the meeting list take on a new look instead of listing all the meetings I think it may be a better idea would be to list all the phone lines with a list of towns by that phone number and web page for that are if appropriate, and the regional website and put this all on a card stock so it is more durable and professional looking, by doing this we would not have to print anything until we have changes in areas or we run out which could save money. In doing this committees and areas may need more meeting list from each area but I still believe this may be a better way than the current meeting list and worth a look”

The web servant reported that the website is being paid for by an addict's personal credit card. They brought it to the bodies' attention that they should look at having this paid directly out of the Treasury.

The Regional website has added the JFT reading to the webpage along with a clean time calculator.

The following was also shared in the Web servant's report-

- “We have constructed a contact form for the regional website that any professional can fill out and receive all related IP's plus the most current meeting list. This is all automated and once the form is filled out, the PR chair would get an email informing them of the request, and the user would receive an email response plus a zip attachment with IP's and meeting list. In the PR budget it was projected about 100 dollars per cycle for this information to be handed out, instead the professional could be directed to the site. Also it has been set up that every 30 days the PR chair and the web servants will receive an automatic list of all the people that filled out the request. This serves two purposes. We will have a better understanding of which areas have the most action with this, giving the PR chair an idea of which areas might need extra attention. The question of “what does region do for areas” is being addressed by getting solid data and services out to all areas in the Wisconsin Region. This new technology can also be adjusted to work in other WRSC Subcommittees. The form has been tested and the technical side is finished. We would like to begin using this technology with the approval of the areas in the Wisconsin Region.”
- Consensus was reached and this link will become live after PR and the web group meet to decide what IP's will be available and the statement given on the website.

The timing for input for the Tradition Book project is as follows Traditions Seven through Ten-1 June - 31 August and Traditions Eleven, Twelve and Closing - 1 July - 30 September

The spiritual Ad-hoc committee reported out on their plan of action -

WRSC 2015 Spiritual Inventory Ad-Hoc

I will let the Ad hoc chair for the Phone Line give a summary as he is present today!

The following proposals were made-

- 1). Region to remove the word “Reserve” inline 2 conference participation reserve section f3.10

Intent: to use funds prudently as article 5.01 states in reimbursements.

Consensus was not reached. The Issue was committed to the treasurer and policy as a conference call with all those interested.

The following two were committed to Policy

- 2). For the Wisconsin region to seek more cost-effective means of conducting the regional service conference by seeking locations other than hotels to hold the WRSC, such as church basements, community centers or schools.

Intent: To save areas and the region money which can be used to carry the message to the addict who still suffers.

3.) For the Wisconsin region to remove policy language which requires RCM's hosting the WRSC to reserve a hotel block & clarify current language to clearly state that those RCM's who choose to host the WRSC in a hotel may reserve a courtesy block of rooms but are under no obligation to do so.

Intent: To help the region and the RCMs save money by allowing them to secure more affordable lodging.

Ad-hoc committees were formed in response to the following two proposals-

4). For the Wisconsin region to seek means of reducing the number of WRSCs held each year.

Intent: to help the region to seek means of reducing the number of WRSC's held each year.

5). Explore bringing back subcommittee meetings at region by allowing time for subcommittees to meet during region.

Intent: Place the focus back to the subcommittees.

On July 16, 2015 Rob Y., Zach H. and myself gave a PR presentation to the Dunn County Youth Coalition.
